You will complete this form using the sentence set (conceptual system) from the last step of Form 12: Term Concept Building Form. You can omit this form.

<Replacement Form>

- ① You will work on this form when you want to re-examine your terms. You will receive insight into your words by testing alternative terms to replace the terms you've been using. Write down the alternative terms that you are using. Transcribe the sentence set from last step of Form 12: Term Concept Building Form, replacing the old terms with your alternative terms.
- ② Write down things you notice freely. Underline the parts you feel are important.
- ③ If needed, change the sentence set (conceptual system).

<Metaphor Form>

- ① You will apply the content expressed in your conceptual system to things outside of your theme. Ask yourself whether there is anything that fits or expresses your conceptual system. If there is anything you can apply, write it down and how you can apply it.
- ② Write down any insights you have through the application. Underline the parts you feel are important. If there is nothing you can apply your conceptual system to, write down why and any insights you have freely. Underline the parts you feel are important.
- ③ As needed, change the sentence set (conceptual system).
